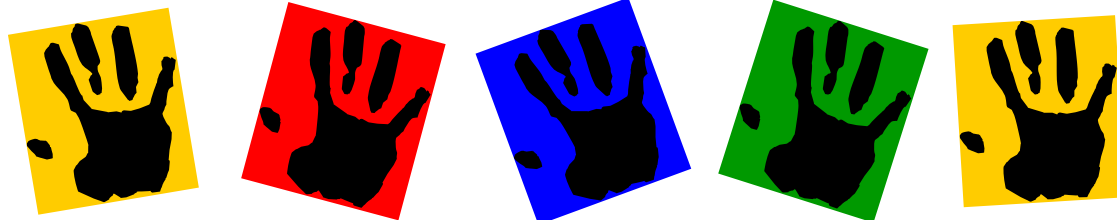

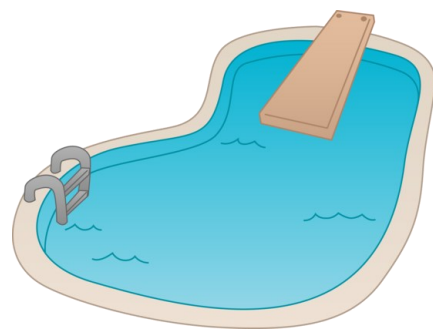
This event is for school age students, 5 and older, who receive CARE therapy services.

Erin Troup LPC, NCC, CT will present "Infant Mental Health" at CARE for Children's annual professional training for Early Intervention professionals and therapists, social workers, educators, para-professionals, and professionals who work with the birth to five population. The workshop will introduce the basic principles of infant and early childhood mental health, brain development, and social emotional development from birth to five.

Troup is a Licensed Professional Counselor specializing in early childhood social emotional needs, particularly attachment, grief and loss, trauma, and anxiety.

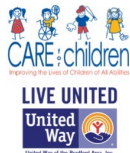

- I walk my bike across streets.
- I look left, right, and left again before I enter or cross a path, sidewalk, street or driveway.
- I continue to look as I cross.
- I ride in a straight line.
- I obey traffic signs and signals.
