Cheyenne provides physical therapy for the Early Intervention program and students receiving school-based services. Cheyanne enjoys working in pediatrics and notes, “the best part of working at CARE is being part of the excitement that children show no matter how big of an accomplishment they have achieved. Kids are the strongest people I know – they work hard and never give up!”

Cheyenne previously worked for Chautauqua Physical & Occupational Therapy in Jamestown, NY and Johns Hopkins All Children’s Hospital in St. Petersburg, FL. She graduated from Gannon University with a Doctorate of Physical Therapy (DPT) degree and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Exercise Science, with minors in Leadership and Coaching, from State University of New York at Fredonia.

Morgan provides speech and language services for the Early Intervention program and students receiving school-based services. Morgan earned a Master of Science degree in Speech-Language Pathology from Clarion University of Pennsylvania in 2022 and a Bachelor of Science degree in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, with a minor in Special Education, from Clarion University of Pennsylvania in 2020. She completed clinical placements at Warren County School District and Rouse Home, a skilled nursing facility in Youngsville, PA. She is currently in her clinical fellowship year, working to achieve the Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC), a nationally recognized professional credential that represents a level of excellence in the field of Speech-Language Pathology. Kylie Battin, M.S., CCC-SLP, CARE speech-language pathologist, is serving as Morgan's mentor during the certification process.

Jessica was most recently employed by the Intermediate Unit 9 3-to 5- year-old classroom that focused on Verbal Therapy/ Applied Behavioral Analysis. She has completed a Credential of Competency for Special Education Paraeducators from the State of Pennsylvania. She also has experience working with children and adolescents in an intensive outpatient program for developmental and behavioral challenges.

She first learned about CARE when one of her foster children received Early Intervention Services from the organization. The kindness and caring of the staff on those home visits made a positive impression and made her want to work at CARE. Jessica began working in the preschool in August and to-date her favorite thing about the culture is that "everyone is so nice, especially the staff and the early learning families; and they all make you feel like you are part of a family."
