FOCUS ON WATER SAFETY FOR YOUNG CHILDREN

The focus was on Water Safety for the *Week of the Young Child (WOYC)* and the month of April. Safe Kids Pennsylvania-McKean County Partner collaborated with CARE for Children, Head Start, and the Intermediate Unit 9 to distribute packets of Water Safety information to program participants ages 5 and under. The packet included a water safety magnet, coloring sheet and parent information.

CARE for Children added a temperature safe duck, which helps ensure a comfortable bath temperature and prevents scalding, to the water safety packets for children who receive Early Intervention Services and/or attend the toddler developmental playgroup at CARE.

According to Safe Kids Worldwide, drowning is the leading cause of injury-related death among children between 1 and 4 years old, and it's the third leading cause of unintentional injury-related death among children 19 and under. Children less than a year old are more likely to drown at home in the bathtub or a bucket.

The educational materials remind parents to watch kids when they are in or around water, without being distracted; empty tubs, buckets, containers and kids' pools immediately after use; close lids and doors; install fences around home pools; and learn CPR and basic water rescue skills.

To illustrate the positive impact of the Ashley Booth Griffin CARE for Children Center, please note how CARE services have grown since the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year:



- Infants and toddlers receiving Early Intervention increased 53%.
- Early Intervention Sessions provided by teachers and therapists increased 87%.
- Students receiving therapy services increased 32%.
- School-based therapy sessions grew by 27%.
- Children and family members benefitting from Community Outreach Services, including Social Work, Special Assistance and Developmental Screenings, increased 24%.
- Children and family members who have been positively impacted by child safety and injury prevention initiatives grew by 25%.
- The annual operating budget increased by 83%.
