## RECREATION PROMOTES THERAPY THROUGH PLAY

## GOLF TOURNAMENT CELEBRATES 30 YEARS

The tournament raised \$38,389 with proceeds benefitting CARE's free community outreach services for children with disabilities; pediatric developmental and preventative screenings; therapeutic recreation programs; and child safety initiatives that prevent disabilities and fatalities from accidental injuries.

## CAR SEAT CHECK EVENT HELD AT CARE



Free car seat safety checks were held on Wednesday, September 20th at the Ashley Booth Griffin CARE for Children Center. Nine car seats were checked and four seats were replaced at no-charge.

The event marked Child Passenger Safety Week. Families who participated received instruction from certified child passenger safety technicians on how to install and use car seats correctly. Technicians also determined if a child was in the correct seat for their age and size, and explained the importance of registering car seats with their manufacturers so parents and caregivers can be notified if there is a recall.

CARE is the lead agency for Safe Kids Pennsylvania-McKean County Partner and partnered with the PA Traffic Injury Prevention Project (TIPP), a program of the PA Chapter American Academy of Pediatrics, to hold the car seat safety event.
