CARE for CHILDREN EARNS 'SEAL of EXCELLENCE'

CARE for Children is again a recipient of the Pennsylvania Association of Nonprofit Organizations' Seal of Excellence for successfully completing the rigorous Standards for Excellence® accreditation program. CARE was first awarded the Seal of Excellence in 2004, and was re-accredited in 2007, 2013, 2017 and most recently in December 2022.

Tyler R. Hannah, president of CARE for Children's Board of Directors commented, "CARE is extremely proud of this accreditation and distinction. Along with our Board of Directors, our staff's hard work proves that CARE operates at maximum efficiency in order to have a maximum impact on our mission of improving the lives of children of all abilities."

CARE for Children voluntarily opened itself up to analysis by a "jury of its peers." The peer review team examined CARE for compliance with the Standards for Excellence®: An Ethics and Accountability Code for the Nonprofit Sector, in areas including: Mission, Strategy and Evaluation; Leadership: Board, Staff, and Volunteers; Legal Compliance and Ethics; Finance and Operations; Resource Development; and Public Awareness, Engagement, and Advocacy.

PANO evaluates fundamental values such as honesty, integrity, fairness, respect, trust, responsibility, and accountability, all of which are inherently important in the nonprofit world. CARE's programs and services, management, fundraising and financial practices were subjected to in-depth examination prior to earning accreditation.

"The process and accreditation demonstrate ethical transparency, organizational sustainability and adherence to best practices," says Karen Gelston, CARE board member and chair of the Policy and Personnel Committee.

"The Seal of Excellence is granted to well-managed, responsibly governed organizations that are deserving of the public's trust," explains Tish Mogan, Standards for Excellence Director for PANO. "CARE's Board and staff have shown an extensive level of commitment to this process, and their pursuit of the Seal of Excellence confirms that they believe strongly in promoting a culture of ethics in their operations and governance."

CARE for Children Recipient of MCCF County Commissioner's Grant

In December 2022, CARE for Children was awarded a \$10,000 grant to support key components of its Community Outreach Program. These services support family-centered programs, that are an extension of therapy services, to help children better reach their full potential, including developmental screenings; social work services; a special assistance fund; and free consultative services in schools and during home visits.

The McKean County Commissioners and the McKean County Community Foundation (MCCF) formed a partnership to distribute grant monies made available to McKean County through the American Rescue Plan Act. As a grant-making entity, MCCF is assisting the Commissioners by processing, awarding, and overseeing the administration of the grants. The McKean County Commissioners and Community Foundation are pleased to provide this opportunity to financially assist the county's non-profits.

ROTARY CLUB of BRADFORD HONORED WITH COMMUNITY CARE AWARD

The CARE Board of Directors honored The Rotary Club of Bradford with the organization's Community CARE Award at the Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors on December 1, 2022.

"This award celebrates The Rotary Club of Bradford's 100th anniversary and even more importantly, the 98-year partnership with CARE for Children that has contributed to the organization's remarkable growth – and positively impacted the lives of thousands of children," noted Tyler R. Hannah, CARE Board President. "The depth and breadth of CARE services has grown significantly since 1924, with Rotary Club support each and every step of the way."

The relationship between CARE and The Rotary Club of Bradford began in 1924, when Rotarians realized that an area as large as McKean County should have a formally organized body whose sole purpose was to better the lot of disabled children. Representatives from local government, the public schools, and the Bradford and Kane Rotary Clubs met to consider founding such an organization. At this first historic meeting the McKean County Society for Crippled Children was officially founded, later becoming the McKean County Easter Seals Society and now, CARE for Children.

Hannah noted many of the Rotary Club's recent contributions, which have included volunteering at recreation programs, providing children with dental supplies and warm coats, purchasing playground and therapy equipment, supporting child safety programs, and completing a significant pledge to the Ashley Booth Griffin CARE for Children Center. The Rotary Club of Bradford also established the Rotary Kids Special Assistance Fund in 1995, which is supported by Rotarians through fundraising and a portion of each members' annual dues. The fund provides emergency assistance and the little extras for CARE families in need.

Accepting the award on behalf of The Rotary Club of Bradford was Steve Morgan, President. Morgan remarked, "It is no surprise that the relationship between CARE and Rotary remains relevant today. Beyond our connected history, our two organizations have much in common. Both CARE for Children and Rotary have been supporting our community for close to a century."

Morgan also noted, "We share a common mission to provide service to people in need. To say that CARE for Children and the Rotary Club of Bradford are connected would certainly be an understatement. Rotary has been a supporter of CARE since the very beginning...almost 100 years!"

The Community CARE Awards were established by the Board of Directors in 2003 to recognize outstanding contributions to the agency and to the children and families to whom CARE provides service.

GRANT FUNDING FOR TODDLER CRIBS

The Dr. Lyle F. Renodin Foundation, a Ministry of the Franciscan Sisters of Allegany, New York, has donated \$3,000 to CARE for Children/Safe Kids Pennsylvania – McKean County Partnership to purchase mini cribs, mattresses and crib sheets to ensure a safe sleep environment for young children.

The mini cribs are specifically for children over 30 pounds and/or older than one year of age who do not meet the guidelines for the McKean County Cribs for Kids* program (birth to 11 months old and under 30 pounds). The new mini cribs will be distributed through the Home Safety Program, which provides childproofing and home safety items for local families in need.

Health and Human Services Agencies, at-home visitors, Children and Youth Services, and early childhood programs are encouraged to make referrals to both the Home Safety and McKean County Cribs for Kids® Programs.
