PARTNERING TOGETHER for FIRE SAFETY

CARE for Children received a grant for \$2,100 from Seneca Resources, the exploration and production segment of National Fuel Gas Company, to purchase smoke detectors to distribute to families during McKean County Kids Fest, held on April 28th, and at other family health and safety events throughout the county.

CARE for Children provides the fiscal leadership for the Safe Kids Pennsylvania - McKean County Partnership and will distribute fire safety educational materials, including a fire safety activity book with a home evacuation planning sheet, which were created and donated by Shriners Hospital, and a free smoke detector with battery as part of the local Safe Kids Fire Safety Program.

"Smoke detectors are the first line of defense for families in the case of fire," said Chief Eric Taylor, Bradford City Fire Department. "When installed correctly, they alert families who may be in another area of the house or asleep, to ultimately get out of the house safely."

CARE for Children received additional funding from Safe Kids Pennsylvania to purchase smoke detectors for its Family Safety Item and Childproofing program for families in need.

"We are very grateful for the grants from Seneca Resources and Safe Kids Pennsylvania in support of CARE's Child Safety and Injury Prevention program and the willingness of the Bradford City Fire Department to help distribute the smoke detectors at Kids Fest and educate families on the importance of this life-saving device," said Tina Martin, executive director at CARE.
