Activities to do at home

<p>Language and Literacy</p> <p>Take your child to the library to get a library card. Have your child help you pick out some books to take home and read.</p>	<p>Math</p> <p>Play shape and color hunt with your child to “find something in the house that is shaped like a circle”. Or, “find something that is blue.” Do the same thing with other shapes and colors. Children love playing “I spy” games.</p>
<p>Science</p> <p>Take your child to the grocery store. Look at apples and talk about the different colors, shapes and sizes. Use words like “same” and “different”.</p>	<p>Social</p> <p>Look through magazines or catalogs with your child for pictures of children doing different things. Talk about each picture. “What is the child doing in this picture?”</p>

Extended Care: Preschool has extended care available until 12:15 for an additional \$2.50 per day. We ask that you sign your child up for the extended care for the day during drop off. If you are going to be late and forget to sign your child up, call the CARE office at 362-4621 to sign your child up for extended care. Children who are still here at 11:10 will automatically be placed in extended care.

Monthly Safety Tip: “Love Them, Buckle Them”:

Engineers are working hard to ensure that cars and car seats are designed to keep kids as safe as possible. But it’s up to every parent to take full advantage of these innovations by making sure car seats and booster seats are used and installed correctly. Seventy-three percent of car seats are not used or installed correctly, so before you hit the road, check your car seat. CARE for Children has a volunteer Child Passenger Safety Technician if you have any concerns. Please contact the main office for a car seat check. We will have fun car seat safety activities during Child Passenger Safety Week September 23rd through 29th.
